Summer & Fall Registration



Registration packets
will be available on
February 14th.

If you are registering your child for BOTH Summer & Fall, please fill out **SEPARATE** Summer & Fall registration packets, and **SEPARATE CHECKS/CASH AMOUNTS** for each.

PRIORITY REGISTRATION

This is for families who **currently** have a child enrolled in our Preschool. Summer and Fall registration packets will be accepted from:

**Friday, February 14 through
Friday, February 21 (3 PM).**

When packets are received, each one will be assigned a number. The Preschool Board will conduct a random LOTTERY DRAW to determine the order of class registration. Children will be placed in classes according to the spaces available. The Board will try to accommodate any specific requests for teachers and/or class schedules.

On **February 25 or 26**, you will get your child's class placement from your current teacher.

Families who missed the Priority Lottery, but were eligible to participate, may turn in their registration packets and be included in the Open Enrollment Lottery.



SUMMER SESSION

It will run from **June 2 - June 27** from **9:00 to 12:00** daily. More details regarding our summer program will be provided with the Summer Registration packet (also available on February 14).

The dates to turn these in are the SAME as the dates for the Fall Registration packets.

OPEN ENROLLMENT REGISTRATION

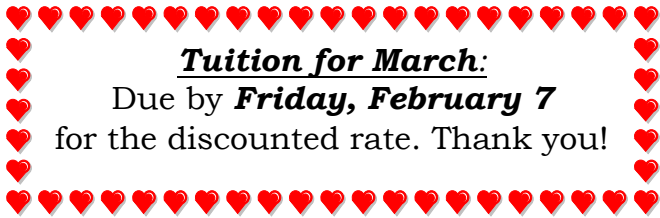
Summer and Fall registration packets for families **not** currently enrolled in our Preschool will be accepted from:

**Tuesday, February 25 through
Tuesday, March 4 (3PM).**

A LOTTERY DRAW for these packets will be done with the identical process as Priority Registration.

On **Thursday, March 6**, we will send parents a text to confirm their child's class placement.

*Beginning **March 7th**, remaining class spots will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.*

Thursday, February 13 & Friday, February 14.

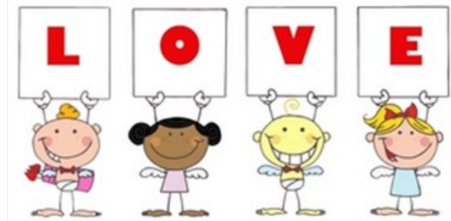
All classes will have a Valentine Card Exchange.
